Glenwood Springs City Council to hold Special Meeting on July 29 regarding Annexation and Initial Rezoning for 214 Center

Glenwood Springs, Colo. – Glenwood Springs City Council is anticipating a large number of persons commenting upon the proposed annexation in West Glenwood at its Special Meeting on Thursday, July 29 at 6 p.m. The City will provide as much seating in council chambers as safely possible, but some seating outside of chambers may be required. City Council will hear public input both in-person and virtually. The remote participation link for Thursday is <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/86788422208>.

Public comments will follow the presentations of staff and the applicant. If the public comment period has not completed by 9:15 p.m. or more time is needed for the hearing, the item will be continued to the next regular City Council meeting on Thursday, August 5.

Mayor Pro Tem, Charlie Willman, thanks the public for their active participation in this important decision. “The City anticipates that there will be extensive community comments this Thursday on this significant decision for the City. I believe that everyone participating wants to contribute to the health safety of all or our residents, so I appreciate everyone adhering to public health recommendations.”

City Council can only consider the information presented as part the hearing. While additional comments will not be added into the packet (which is published online), emails submitted to staff will be shared with City Council as part of their consideration for the hearing. Public comment will alternate between in-person and virtual comment each ten participants.
